I am a motivated PGA Assistant (Germany), who has a background in developing junior and adult players, has experience in coaching, such as individual lessons, group classes, beginner classes and was involved in the inner works of a golfclub.

Part of my skillset are excellent communication as also developed knowledge of the technical and physical parts of golf coaching.

I am very passionate about player development and creating a motivating and fun training environment for golfers of all ages and levels.

Sven Strüver is a former 3x European Tour Winner, and every year his academy was comprised of around 4 fully qualified PGA Pros and 5 PGA Assistants

- I taught 3- and 5-day "Platzreife" (handicap certificate) classes for all ages
- I taught multi-day classes with the aim of improving the handicap of players
- I gave youth classes for juniors wanting to get their "DGV Kinder-Golfabzeichen" (Handicap certificate for children), and classes for more advanced juniors wanting to improve their existing handicap
- I gave Individual one on one lessons for all ages and levels

2024–2025: Boarding School: "Internatsgymnasium Schloss Torgelow"

- I trained the youth team of the boarding school on a weekly basis with the coaching focus being on-course training plus technical work on the driving range
- During the Summers 2023-2024, I took care of a group of 6 kids for each week during two weeks of their summer golf camps. The coaching focus was on introducing the kids

to golf and getting them ready for their handicap certificate (DGV Kinder-Golfabzeichen).

2023–present: Private Coaching

- I delivered individual training for players across all handicap ranges
Being in Luxemburg, I continue to instruct a specific German player who came to me in summer of 2024 with a handicap of 12. He played a round average of 89. I coach him via messages and video. Within 6 months of coaching we got him to single digits. Today he has a handicap of 5,4 (he plays rounds of high 70s, low 80s). In the regional championship, he ranked 7th place overall and 2nd place in the age category 30+.
- I supervised the development of swing technique, pre- and post-shot routines and training plans
- I used data-driven analysis via Trackman and other tools to support my students.

2017-2020: Winter Junior Training

- As a junior I co-led the weekly junior outdoor training from October-March.
- I primarily worked on the technical aspects of the game (short game & putting).
- I supervised games-based learning, such as chipping into umbrellas, playing closest to the pin during these sessions.

I represented the Luxembourg Golf Federation (FLG) at the COSL (national Olympic committee) “Spillfest” and introduced hundreds of children and adults to golf using SNAG Golf[®]

- Knowledge using Technology & Analysis Tools such as:
 - Trackman, Skytrak, Flightscope Mevo, PC Caddie (PC Caddie is a Golf management software used in 15 countries across Europe and Africa, such as Germany, Luxemburg and Morocco)
- I'm familiar with video analysis; in cooperation with the students, I analysed the swing pattern and determined how to change them; I looked at the before and after; how to change the patterns without my presence; I used videos and messages to transmit different swing tips.
- As a PGA trainee I improved my physical knowledge; studied Biomechanics, Anatomy and Sports related injuries.

- Pro shop assistance: I helped with the purchase, the sale, the Inventory and design the Pro Shop layout

- Teamwork: during my traineeship we mostly were 7 trainees at once; giving introductory classes for firms that included 30+ people; taking care of the logistics for tournaments
- Tournament organization & scoring: I organised multiple tournaments from beginning to the finish
- Marshall & Starter duties: I often was the Marshall on the different golf courses and executed the function of starter for tournaments.
- During my traineeship I created an eclectic-format tournament series for all the employees of the golf resort. The series spread over 6 months; 6 rounds each on 2 different courses for two different handicap groups (54-37, 36-scratch). I organised everything, from scheduling, the communication, the flights, the management in PC Caddie, the trophies and the award presentation event.
